**JOHN NORMAN MACLEOD**

John Norman MacLeod was born in Hartsville, PEI in 1924. He left his formal education to help support the family and basically taught himself, with a passion and curiosity to learn and work, all of the skills used in construction, from concrete finishing, to painting, finish carpentry, estimating, cost accounting and management. Norman was promoted to Regional Construction Manager with MF Schurman Co and later in 1960 was hired as Project Manager by a large Quebec general contractor to manage a major project at CFB Summerside that included significant infrastructure, three hangars including the Cantilever and employed 300 men. The rest, as they say is history. He was a trailblazer and builder within the construction community in PEI and his corporate positions are impressive and varied:

He was co-founder and held executive roles in many Island construction companies, including Williams, Murphy & MacLeod, Prebilt Structures Ltd, Prebilt Homes & Prebilt Steel, and Sherwood Building Supplies Ltd., was a co-founder and shareholder in Metro Building Supplies Ltd., and co-founder and was an investor in Kinlock Creek Ltd. He is presently Chairman of the Board of WM & M (1993) Ltd. & Tile Master Ltd.

He has been vitally interested and involved with various municipal level groups, service groups, and charitable organizations in his Community including the village of Sherwood, Park Royal Church, The Charlottetown Regional Planning Board and the Charlottetown Pollution Control Board, the Rotary Club and the Y'men's Club among many others.

Norman is a very successful businessman and we are pleased to include him as a very deserving recipient of the JA Business Hall of Fame award.
